Call to Order Mayor Saric called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Adoption of Agenda

Business

(a) Rezoning Request

A request was received to rezone 4640 Sawchuk Street to allow for a maximum of four horses on the property.

Richard Shelast was present to discuss the rezoning request.

Discussion took place.

- a number of years ago there was cows and chickens on the property.
- property in not serviced; therefore it is hard to sell as residential or commercial.
- no immediate neighbors
- property is on the edge of Town
- concerns if Town is liable if the horses get loose.
- concerns that people will request to be allowed to have horses can open a pandoras box.

11/120 Gargus that 4640 Sawchuk Street be rezoned to allow for a maximum of four horses on the property.
