## Snow Removal

Snow clearing priorities are as follows; main street, other town streets, then back alleys.

### **\*\*ON-LINE PAYMENTS\*\*** **(ALL ACCOUNTS)**

When making your online payments, whether it be A/R (bulk water), Taxes, or Water/Sewer bills, **please make sure you have the right sub account selected ie; utilities, or taxes or A/R**. When paying your utility bill, enter the account number exactly as it is shown(13 numbers) on the top of your utility bill, if you were already signed up with your banking, please check to see if you have the right account number. If the account numbers you have on your banking payment system is wrong, the payment will be rejected by our system.

If you are paying your **taxes**, please make sure you have selected the sub account as taxes and use your roll number(6 numbers), do not enter first three 0's . If you need help with this, feel free to give us a call. (780)764-3929.


Sign up for Pre-authorized payment plan (monthly payment plan) for your taxes, to do this stop in with a blank cheque and fill out the form. If you can't make it during business hours, I can send the form to you through email.

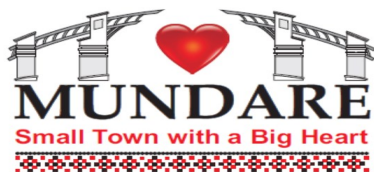
### Busy times at Mundare School
