Life at Mundare School has been very busy this year. We recently hosted a very successful Read-in Week. A lot of great reads were shared with community partners coming to read, as well.

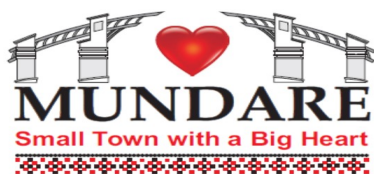
