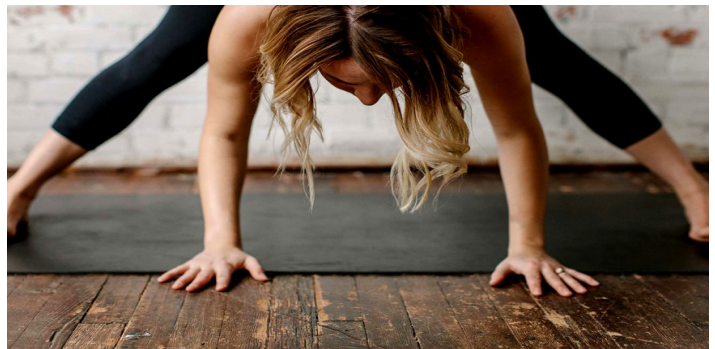

LIBRARY NEWS

Mundare Municipal Public Library Relaunch Plan



Mundare Library Board is preparing for a tentative Safe Relaunch beginning at the end of September.

The following PPE's will be provided:

*Plexiglas sneeze barrier will be mounted on the circulation desk.

*Disposable gloves and hand sanitizer will be provided for patrons

*Facemasks will be provided to patrons without face coverings.

Patrons can help support a safe relaunch by following public health measures, practicing physical distancing and good hygiene, and continuing to act responsibly.

Stay informed– Alberta.ca/covid19

At this time, the library will continue to offer curbside service on Tuesdays. Patrons who have placed items on hold will be notified, by telephone, that the item (s) will be placed in a new plastic bag, labelled and left on the table near the ATB for pick up daily (during Town of Mundare office Hours).

In September the library manager will be on site on **Tuesday and Thursdays from 10am to 2pm**. Once all safety protocols are in place for patrons to enter the library, notice will be given for the official relaunch. When the library manager is on site, patrons can communicate with the library manager through the main library door, or by telephone.

Re-Launch Plan:

Signs will be posted on the front door of the Town of Mundare building and in front of the library door directing patrons on safe enter and exit to the library. These signs will instruct patrons on the current procedures for browsing and borrowing items. Directional arrows will be installed on the floor.

Borrowing Patrons

- Will be asked to enter the library through the door to the left of the library entrance.

This will be marked with a sign that says "Entrance". Only one person at a time may enter the library.

- Hand sanitizer and gloves will be available for patrons, **Use is mandatory**
- Patrons will be asked to wait in front of the plexiglass at the front desk when checking out.
- Once items are checked out, they will be put in a new plastic bag.
- Patrons will be asked to dispose of gloves in the container provided upon leaving the library.

Return Items can be dropped in the drop box or in a bin that will be in the entrance to the library.

Computer use will not be included in the relaunch at this time.

Safety protocols

Limiting the number of patrons in the library will allow for frequent sanitizing and compliance with social distancing. Sanitizing of the library will take place before opening and throughout the day.

Patrons who are visibly ill or have been in contact with someone who is, are asked to comply with COVID-19 protocol and do not enter.

All returned items will be stored for 72 hours before they are shelved or put on the courier bin. Incoming courier items will remain in the bin for the same 72 hours before they are checked in.

This is the current relaunch plan proposed by the Mundare Library Board. Changes may have to be made quickly if the situation changes.

We ask for your patience and understanding as we work towards a viable relaunch service model
