Hands on History Festival- To celebrate the 130th anniversary of Ukrainian settlement in Canada, the Basilian Fathers Museum would like to invite you to their Hands on History festival featuring a farmer's market, a contemporary art exhibit and a launch of the Sawchuk Summer House restoration project on Saturday September 11, 2021 from 8:30am-2:30 pm.

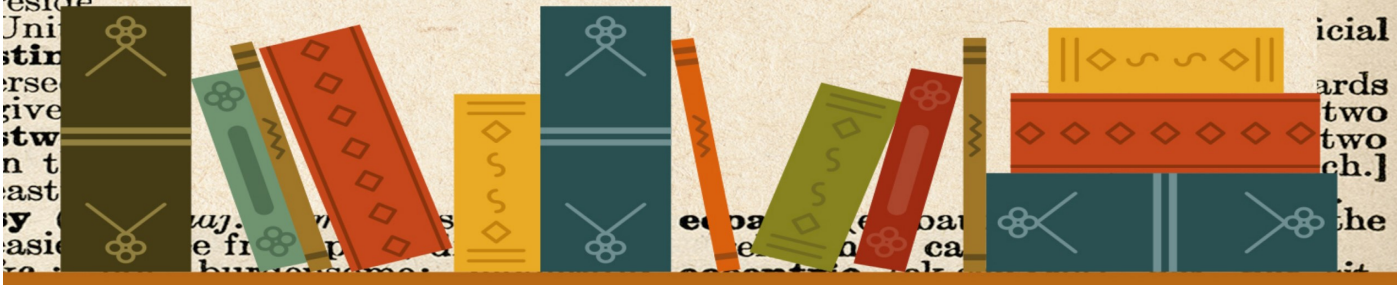
