LIBRARY NEWS

Mundare Municipal Public Library remains CLOSED until further notice.

Public libraries in Alberta may now reopen with Stage 2 of the Province's Re-launch Strategy; however, as borrowed books must be in quarantine for 72 hours, there will be a delay in returning to regular library operations.

The Mundare Library Board and Library Manager continue to implement Alberta Health Services' guidelines to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. We have unanimously decided to keep Mundare Library closed, but beginning July 7th patrons will have opportunities to obtain curbside pick-up of items while minimizing risks(see our procedures below).

Once our preparations are complete, and it is safe to do so, the library will be reopened to the public. A timeline will be shared, at a later date.

Mundare Municipal Public Library Curbside Pick-up Service

Tuesdays 1:00pm to 4:00 pm

How does it work?

1. Patrons place a **HOLD** on items from the Mundare Library collection. Only items from the Mundare Library are available at this time. No van runs are scheduled.
2. Library Manager will check the items out on your account. A **maximum of 4 items** at one time may be checked out.
3. Once your items are ready, **you will be telephoned to schedule a**

pick up (Tuesday 1:00 pm to 4:00pm)

Items from the library will only be available for pick-up at pre-arranged times, in 15 minute intervals

4. Library manager will meet you at the **bench outside of the Town of Mundare Library)**

Return Items can be placed in the **Book Drop** box outside the library. Items will be quarantined for 72 hours. After the quarantine period, the items will be checked in and put back on the shelves.

For patrons without internet or access to email, a sign-up sheet will be located near the entrance to the Town of Mundare Office and is available Monday to Friday during office hours.

This service is also available to patrons who are not able to contact the Library Manager on a Tuesday. Please Provide –your name-telephone number (if different from the one on your membership)- maximum of 4 items to be checked out.

We strongly suggest that you sanitize your hands before and after picking up library items.

The Mundare Library shares a telephone number with the Town of Mundare. Please restrict calls regarding curbside pick up to Tuesdays when the Library manager is on site
