Hello,

On behalf of Lamont County, we are seeking community members to apply for the *Intermunicipal Subdivision Development and Appeal Board (ISDAB)*. This board is the local committee established to hear all subdivision and development appeals before it proceeds to the Land and Property Rights Tribunal (if it is of provincial interest or as required), as set out in Part 17, Division 10 of the *Municipal Government Act*, in accordance with the MGA and [ISDAB Bylaw 801.19](#).

The ISDAB is an independent tribunal established by County Council that hears appeals relating to:

- Decisions of the Development Authority regarding development permit applications;
- Enforcement orders issued by the Development Authority; and
- Decisions of the Subdivision Authority regarding subdivision applications.

The Board is made up of community members and residents from Lamont County and its surrounding communities (both within the County and neighbouring municipalities).

Up to 12 members will be named to this board, and the appointment term runs to December 31, 2025.

We are seeking your assistance to identify and encourage members from your municipality to apply for this role.
