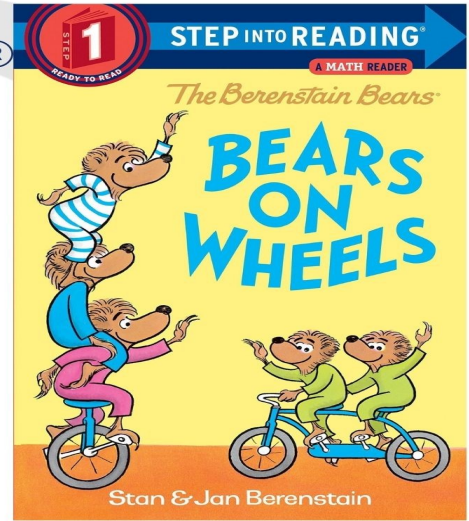
## STORYWALK®
