## Council Updates

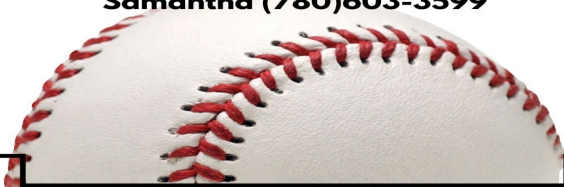
