The notice of assessment date is June 20, 2023. The assessment roll is available for inspection at the Town of Mundare Administration office from 9am-5pm, Monday to Friday. Any person who objects to the assessment value placed upon a property must lodge their complaint(s) on the prescribed form by August 21, 2023 with a \$50 fee.

Property Taxes are due and payable on or before July 31
