There is a 5% discount on the municipal portion of your taxes if prepaid between January 1 and 31, 2023. A Monthly installment payment program is also available if your account is in good standing. Forms for this are available at the town office. A 10% Penalty will be added to any outstanding taxes as of January 1, 2024. Contact the town office for details.
