### <u>2024</u> Town Tax Notices


Tax notices will be in the mail soon, if you have a new mailing address, or if you have not received your notice by June 30 please contact us.

The notice of assessment date is June 21, 2024. The assessment roll is available for inspection at the Town of Mundare Administration office from 8:30 am-4:30pm, Monday to Friday. Any person who objects to the assessment value placed upon a property must lodge their complaint(s) on the prescribed form by August 20, 2024 with a \$50 fee.

Property Taxes are due and payable on or before July 31

Please note a 10% penalty will be applied August 1, 2024.

Please contact the town if you are unsure on how you can pay.
