Things to consider when buying Rural Property

CONSIDER THE WELL AND SEPTIC SYSTEM



You will need to have your own water source and septic system

The Septic System size, age and type are important to know before you buy.

Will the size be big enough for your family? How much maintenance would be involved with the type of system? Is it nearing it's lifespan and what condition is it in?

The water source could be a drilled or bored well or a cistern. It is important to note flow rate of the well and to get a potability test done.

For a cistern you'll want to know size, age, maintenance requirements.
