PET LICENSES ARE NOW DUE

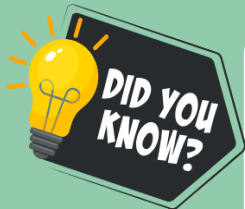
Due every January after
your pet is 6 months old.



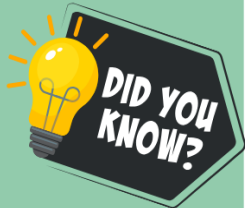

A 5% tax discount towards the balance of your taxes is available, if you prepay the municipal portion of your property taxes between January 1 and 31, 2025

Princh Wireless Printing Service.

Princh allows patrons to print and pay from their own devices (or library PCs) through a user-friendly webpage. The main consideration is that the computer will need to be turning on for Princh to work. At this time the Town of Mundare would like to announce this incoming service.

Take Action on Radon

Radon is a radioactive gas that comes from the breakdown of uranium in soil and rock. It is invisible, odorless and tasteless. When radon is released from the ground into the outdoor air, it is diluted and is not a concern. However, in enclosed spaces, like homes, it can accumulate to high levels and become a risk to the health of Canadians.

Once set up, digital radon monitors may be borrowed from the library as a screen tool only. All patrons need to conduct a long-term radon test or hire a radon measurement professional to get an accurate measurement of the radon level in their home. There is a company in Edmonton called Radontech solutions their web site is radontech.ca and a phone number is (587)937-2366
