Residential Recycling

Effective April 1, 2025, Circular Materials will be taking over responsibility for recycling for residential properties.

There is no expected change in the service at this time.

Commercial businesses who receive hand picked recycling are not included and will not be receiving recycling services after April 1, 2025

As a result of this change, the cost of the first garbage bin will be reduced by \$5.65 from \$25.80 to \$20.15 per month, effective April 1, 2025.
